At 13 he joined a school with an integrated tennis academy that allows students to

play as much tennis as possible during a school day. From here his level kept increasing and began to make a natural transition from regional, then nationals, and finally ITF tournaments. By his junior and senior year, Anonymous had won a couple of ITF Junior titles and competed in Junior Wimbledon.

The NCAA Division I men's basketball tournament is one of the biggest sporting events in the world, and every year, millions of fans tune in to watch the excitement unfold.
